There will be firstly, a focus on teaching Philosophy in classrooms and developing relevant assessment criteria for Philosophy Achievement Standards; and secondly, a focus on a national strategy to increase the number of Philosophy teachers in secondary schools who can develop in students a critical awareness of ethical "Values" and guide them in acquiring the intellectual and interpersonal skills that underlie the "Key Competencies", identified in the current New Zealand curriculum.
